ADMISSIONS POLICY

Where applications for admission exceed the number of places available the following criteria will be applied in the order set out below, to decide which children to admit:

- I. Children who are members of the Roman Catholic Church attending Roman Catholic Primary Schools.
- II. Other children who are members of the Roman Catholic Church.
- III. Non-Catholics attending Roman Catholic Primary Schools.
- IV. Brothers and sisters of existing pupils.
- V. Children baptised into other churches: The governors will have regard to the degree of Christian commitment. A letter from the vicar or minister may be required to show the child/family are practising.
- VI. Special admission on social or medical grounds (this may need to be supported by a certificate from a doctor or social worker) at the discretion of the Governing Body.
- VII. Children whose grandparents, but not parents are Catholic.
- VIII. Within each category, those living nearer the school will be given preference.
