EASTER LETTER TO PARENTS

Dear Parents

I am sure that you are aware by now that Torfaen LEA has put forward proposals to reorganise post 16 education in the borough. There have been many objections to this from the Governing Body at St Alban's, from the staff, the students and many parents and while others may argue the case for the post 16 reorganisation, as Headteacher I feel the objections are well founded.

Our sixth form provides a special environment that I think is pretty unique and I am reminded of this almost daily. Let me describe just a few examples. Our sixth form mock trial team were crowned Welsh champions for the second year running and have recently participated in the UK finals in the Royal Courts of Justice in London. We are still waiting the final placings but we believe the team did very well. Our sixth form engineering team have also become Welsh champions. Their design of a new braking system for lorries using lasers to guide how efficiently brake pads can be applied and removed, leading to less wear and tear and a significant reduction in harmful dust particles, is indeed a worthy winner. The team now go forward to the UK engineering final in Birmingham in a few weeks and they are hopeful of success. In addition to these exceptional successes, there are activities that we have taken for granted as a routine part of our sixth form life such as our Choir and our School Productions, and the Cast of 'Joseph' excelled again this year. Our students have also participated in visits to Westminster and Auschwitz and played a very active role in raising money for CAFOD.

Being in St Alban's sixth form is being part of a special environment and a special culture and you have only to read the Facebook message boards of our many alumni to realise how important St Alban's was in shaping their lives. There are many young people who have benefitted greatly from being part of our sixth form environment; it is a great shame that young people in the future may be deprived of this opportunity.

St Alban's R.C. High School may face some changes, however, because the school is built on rock solid foundations of very strong culture and values it will continue to thrive and be successful – whatever comes our way.

Elsewhere there have been other notable successes: Our Senior netball teams both received awards at the South East Wales Netball presentation evening. The Year 11 team won the South East Wales area round of the Ann Smart Trophy and went on to represent the area in the regional finals. They were one of eight teams at the finals from across the whole of Wales. The standard of netball was extremely high and the girls were a credit to the school. The team ended up finishing 4th best in Wales which is a considerable achievement that no other netball team from this school has ever done. The Year 10 team have also had a successful season, winning the Year 10 league. They won their group and went on to play Monmouth Comprehensive School in the Semi-finals and then Caerleon in the final. Congratulations to all involved!
