School Kit Policy

Thanks to the support of parents and pupils , the Physical Education Department has an excellent level of participation by pupils in all year groups.

Please help us maintain this by ensuring your son / daughter follows the policy detailed below.

- Pupils are expected to bring correct kit to every lesson.
- If unable to take part pupils must provide a note.
- Where pupils are unable to participate for an extended period of time a doctors note will be required.
- All pupils must bring full PE kit with them to every lesson and get changed even if they are injured or unwell. If their injury prevents them from getting changed this must be clearly stated in their note.

The reasons for this policy :

1. Pupils will be given a role in the lesson that will not need them to be as fully or strenuously involved as normal, for example as a scorer, peer observer or referee.

2. Depending on the activity pupils will be required to go outside. Even if they are not participating fully, it is important the pupils bring their kit in case of rain or other inclement weather. This will ensure pupils are not wearing wet uniform for the rest of the day.
