Dear Parent / Guardian,

There will be a Welsh activity course for Gwent schools to the Urdd centre at Llangrannog West Wales for year 7 pupils from Monday 11th to Wednesday 13th January 2016. Your son / daughter has shown an interest in attending this course. The purpose of the course is to broaden and enhance the pupils' knowledge of Welsh in the most natural way possible i.e. whilst taking part in the various activities that are available at the centre. Full time specialist instructors with appropriate qualifications and experience supervise the main activities, i.e. the ski and toboggan slopes, salto-trampolines, go-karts, swimming pool, pony trekking, all terrain quad-bikes, ropes course, archery and sports centre. The pupils will be accompanied and supervised by St. Alban's staff along with the centre's specialist instructors.

The cost of the trip will be **£155** which includes transport, all meals and activities at the centre, and the necessary membership of the Urdd. We need to know as soon as possible if students wish to attend in order to secure their places. A non-refundable deposit of **£75** will be required to secure your child's place by the 6th of November. The remaining balance of **£80** will need to be paid by 11th of December. PLEASE ENSURE THAT WHERE POSSIBLE, MONEY IS PAID VIA PARENT PAY.

Making a payment is easy and simple. PARENTPAY holds an electronic record of your payments to view at a later date and no card details are stored in any part of the system. You can also make online payments for school meals.
