NEW UNIFORM GUIDE Acceptable Uniform



Compulsory Girls

- Black blazer and school badge
- School tie*
- White shirt, short or long sleeved with collar
- A-line badged knee length black skirt or tailored straight leg black trousers
- Black tights or black socks
- Short white socks can be worn with skirts
- Traditional black leather shoes - no canvas/VAN style trainers
- A plain school bag
- V-Neck Black Jumper can be worn under blazers (not instead of)



Compulsory Boys

- Black Blazer and school badge
- School tie*
- White shirt, short or long sleeved with collar
- Black tailored trousers
- Black socks
- Traditional black leather shoes No canvas/VAN style trainers
- A plain school bag
- V-Neck Black Jumper can be worn under blazers (not instead of)

General Uniform Guidance

- Aside from single piercings in each ear, no other visible body piercings are permitted. This includes nose, tongue and eyebrows.
- We do not encourage pupils to wear make-up, however, if make-up is worn it should be subtle and discreet. Pupils will be asked to remove make up that is gaudy or excessive. Pupils are NOT permitted to have false nails and nail varnish MUST be subtle.
- On non-uniform days pupils should wear appropriate clothing and suitable shoes (no vest or cropped tops/short skirts).
- Hair must not be dyed other than a natural colour and should not be cut in an extreme style.

- Hooded sweatshirt (Navy with school badge)**
- Shorts (Navy)
- Sports socks (Navy/Sky)
- Trainers

Boys Games Kit

- Reversible rugby shirt (Navy/Sky with school badge)
- Rugby Shorts - (Navy)
- Rugby Socks - (Navy/Sky)
- Rugby/Football Boots

*Please note that the design of the tie changes for pupils in Years 10 and 11
